

## SSSA Slack / Online Rules of Procedure

1. The current version in publication of *Roberts Rules of Order* shall govern online meetings and voting for this Association, unless superseded by policies and rules as approved by the Executive Committee, Council, or general membership, as provided in our Bylaws.
2. Once a motion has been moved and seconded (or moved in the case of a committee motion), the president (or the member presiding) shall cause to be posted a poll on Slack to collect the votes of those entitled to do so.
3. The poll shall remain open for not less than 24 hours and not more than 48 hours, rounding to the nearest hour for its starting time. If the president or presiding member does not specify a deadline, the poll shall close 48 hours after it opens.
4. The president or presiding member may extend the poll by a period not to exceed 48 hours in the event that technical or other circumstances warrant such an extension.
5. Votes shall be cast in the poll. Votes written in the text thread shall not be counted, unless a member is technically unable to use the polling feature.
